These classes are split into two groups as the environment changes dependant on the stage of the child, Mini Toddler (18 - 24 months) and Toddler (24 - 36 months). The Parent Toddler Program provides structured, individualised developmental activities that develop:

- building self-esteem and confidence
- developing their concentration span
- developing fine motor skills

The program provides age-appropriate, real-life practical experiences to foster the development of these life skills.
